

Commuting At A Glance

75% MBTA Pass Subsidy

(maximum subsidy of \$300) is available to all benefits-eligible employees. Requests for passes must be made by the 10th of the previous month. Commuter Rail passes are mailed to your home address. LINK and Bus passes are picked up at the Parking Office. 10-Ride Commuter Rail passes are delivered electronically via the MBTA M-Ticket App.

Monthly Parking Available

There are various onsite (\$250 - \$588) and offsite (\$150-\$171) parking options available.

Daily Parking Passes

Are Available for various parking facilities with pricing ranging between \$12 to \$22 daily.

Fellows and Residents Parking

Fellows and Residents are eligible to get complimentary evening and weekend parking in the BCH Patient Family Garage. You can enter the garage weekdays after 5 pm (24-hour access weekends and holidays) and you must exit by 10:00 am the next day. Fellows and Residents are also offered discounted monthly parking and daytime daily parking options. Please contact the Parking Office in advance to sign up for these options.

Weekend, Evening, and Holiday Parking for All Monthly Off-site Lots

If you have monthly parking at any of our off-site lots (such as Renaissance, Beacon, or Ipswich) you are eligible for free onsite weekend, evening, and holiday parking. You can enter and exit your assigned garage weekdays between 4:30 pm and 10:00 am the next day (24-hour access weekends and holidays). Please contact the parking office to set up your access in advance.

Weekend, Evening, and Holiday Parking for Commuter Rail Riders

If you purchase your monthly commuter rail passes through the parking office (Zone 1 or higher), you can take advantage of free onsite evening, weekend, and holiday parking. You can enter your assigned garage weekdays between 6:00 pm and 9:00 am the next day (24-hour access weekends and holidays).

Free Overnight Parking

Free onsite overnight parking is available for all employees who are working a night shift. You can enter your assigned garage weekdays between 6:00 pm and 9:00 am the next day. Pre-registration is required at the Parking Office.

WageWorks Commuting Program

Employees who use mass transit outside of the MBTA (such as Amtrak or Concord Trailways) can now order passes through the WageWorks Benefits website, pay for them through payroll deductions, and be subsidized 75% up to \$280 per month.

WageWorks Parking Subsidy

The WageWorks Parking Subsidy Program allows employees to manage their daily parking payments in a manner similar to flex-spending for healthcare. You would set up a regular pre-tax payroll deduction and then submit reimbursements for parking use.

ZipCar Discounts

Boston Children's Hospital Employees pay no joining fees and a \$35 annual fee for using ZipCar. There are currently 17 ZipCars in the Longwood Medical Area. Rentals start at \$9.25 per hour.

Blue Bike Bicycle Sharing

BCH employees can purchase an annual Blue Bike membership for \$52.50. This program provides rental bicycles that can be picked up and dropped off at any of the 61 solar-powered stations set up throughout the city. This service works like Zipcar with bicycles instead of cars.

BCH Bicyclists Discount Program

If your primary method of commuting to work is by bike and you are not enrolled in any other monthly commuter program through the hospital (such as MBTA) you may be able to take advantage of 20% discounts and up to one tune-up a year with Landry's Bicycles. Pre-registration is required.

Movie, Ski, and Amusement Park Tickets

The Parking Office sells movie tickets, ski lift tickets (seasonal) and amusement park tickets (seasonal).
